Sub:- Admissions in existing BHMS course with 100 seats and PG Course with 06 seats in 3 subjects namely Materia Medica , Organon of Medicine, Repertory, for the year 2020-21 at P. D Jain Homeopathic Medical College, Vakil Colony, Parbhani – regd.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the provisions prescribed under Section 12C of the Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and regulations made thereunder and Ministry's policy for the academic year 2020-21, In order to verify the compliance of availability of standards by the College, the Board of Governors to CCH has examined the documents submitted by the college authority for the admissions for the academic year 2020-21 in 1-BHMS course with intake capacity of 100 seats and MD (Hom) Course in 03 subjects with six (06) seats in each subject namely Homoeopathic Materia Medica, Organon of Medicine and Repertory at **P. D Jain Homeopathic Medical College, Vakil Colony, Parbhani**, and furnished recommendation vide its letter No. F.No. 15-8/2020-CCH (Visitation Matter) 2536 dated 22.09.2020 as under:-

"Recommended for allowing admission in I-BHMS Course for the session 2020-21 with the intake capacity of 100 seats in existing UG (BHMS) course and 14 seats in M.D. (Hom) Course with intake capacity of 04 seats each in the subject of Materia Medica & Repertory and 06 seats Organon of Medicine."

2. The college was granted an opportunity of hearing through Video-Conferencing to present their case on 05.10.2020. The college authority submitted the compliance report.

3. After considering the provisions of section 12C (1) of Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and HCC(MSR) Regulations, 2013, recommendations of the Board of Governors to CCH, and report of the designated Hearing Committee of this Ministry, **permission of the Central Government is hereby granted to P. D Jain Homeopathic Medical College, Vakil Colony, Parbhani for continuing admissions in 1- BHMS course during the academic year 2020-21 with intake capacity of 100 seats and PG Course in 03 subjects namely Materia Medica, Organon of Medicine, with six (06) seats each and Repertory with four (04) seats.**

4. It is further informed that, minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of BHMS course shall be treated as All India quota. The counselling for seats under All India quota shall be conducted by respective counselling Authority of State / UT Government as designated by the Central Government vide letter F. No. L. 11011/02/2020-E- (1) dated 26.10.2020 for A.Y. 2020-21 and counselling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counselling Authority of that State / UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government for All India quota or the students admitted thereunder.

5. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under HCC Act & Regulations made thereunder. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of CCH and the Central Government.

6. The College shall comply with the provision for providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, Non-teaching staff of the College/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provident Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.

7. Further, the College shall submit the procedure to get permanent registration of the Teachers,/ Hospital Clinical Staff/ Consultant in concerned State Boards/ Council where the college/ hospital is located or Central Registration of CCH by 31st December, 2020 as per the decision conveyed vide CCH's letter no. 15-1/2018-CCH(3)/18510-18768, dated 16th January, 2019 and decided by the High Court of Delhi in W.P. No. 2369 of 2019, which will be verified by the Council during next visitation while considering the matter for grant of permission for the A.Y. 2020-21.

8. The College has to comply with the full requirements of HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013 by 31st December, 2020 for continuing admissions during the subsequent year. A copy of the compliance report shall be submitted by the college to CCH under intimation to this Ministry. Subsequently, CCH shall verify the compliance well in time for considering the admissions during the Academic Year 2021-22 and furnish the recommendation to the Central Government.
